

RESEARCH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT



What is Research Information Management (RIM)?

The aggregation, curation, & utilization of metadata about research activities [at a research institution]



Overlapping term:


CRIS (Current Research Information System) (Metis, Pure, Converis)



- RIMs ≠ researcher platforms like ResearchGate or Academia.edu
- RIM ≠ Research Data Management (RDM)





Netherlands NARCIS




- National reporting requirements ("top-down"); new: OA
- Strong culture of collaboration



Finland






- National reporting requirements
- Funding based on research productivity




Germany



- No top-down incentives
- Decision making intensely local

- No top-down incentives
- Decision making intensely local



Emerging patterns

- Varies strongly depending on incentives
- Stronger above the institution mandates
 - → higher RIM activity, "professionalization" (e.g. CRIS)
- National level organizations drive scaling
- Local institutions will focus on local priorities in the absence of external drivers or mandates.





Something to consider

- Do not take for granted what you have ...
- Scaling is easier when "sufficiently small".
- Collaboration is key to change also at the local level.
 Convene, collaborate, commit to facilitate local change.





LIBRARIES IN RIM



Emerging patterns

- Project "CRIS" often starts in administration
- Library involvement varies and starts late
 - Stronger in NL & FI
 - Stronger in CRIS implementation or post-implementation phase, when outreach, education and customer support become important.
- Libraries logical choice for metadata management and user support, i.e. traditional library services and values



Library roles in RIM

Metadata Management

- enter publication metadata in CRIS
- validate metadata entered by researchers or harvested from external sources
- linkages to repositories for publications and datasets
- open access compliance





Library roles in RIM

User Support – "information literacy" for 21st century scholars

- help manage public profiles and scholarly reputation
- train export / import metadata from other sources
- assist in fulfilling OA deposit obligations
- educate on copyright issues
- raise awareness of tools like ORCID





But there is **SO much** libraries can offer!

(And yes, this can be daunting.)





Opportunities for libraries in RIM

Opportunities

- to leverage existing skillset in new and highly visible ways
- to collaborate with the wider institution,
 in solving institutional and researcher problems
- to learn from other campus experts such as research administration or academic review
- to raise awareness for professional data management across the institution


